3- Road signs into the village need cleaning. This is no longer carried out by Highways but R Hill said that he would get them cleaned.

4 – Village signs. These need repainting. **ACTION: LN to contact Bill Radley, who did them last time to see if he is willing to do them again**.

5 – Dog bin opposite village hall is in a state. **ACTION: LN to investigate.** 

6- Bus shelter opposite the church is over grown with Ivy. This needs to be removed.

7- Phone Box. This is an eyesore. LN in process of arranging to get it removed by BT.
